Adult Day Care provides a caring, supervised environment for the impaired, mature adult and promotes:

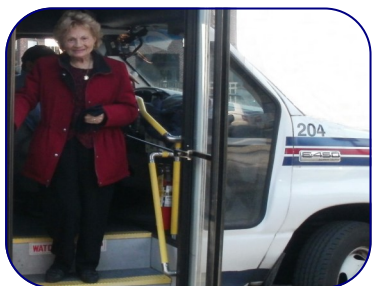

ELIGIBILITY

The participant must be:

- ◆ A Suffolk County resident
- ◆ 60 years of age or older in most instances
- ◆ Able to handle personal hygiene with minimal assistance *
- ◆ Able to eat independently *
- ◆ Able to participate in a limited manner within a group setting



*Unless accompanied by a personal aide

We are open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Participants may attend one to five days a week. Our fees are budget-friendly and accepted by some long-term care insurance plans and Medicaid Managed Care.

Transportation with handicapped accessibility is available for Town of Huntington residents through HART, and for other Suffolk residents through SCAT.

Coordinated respite care & caregiver programs are jointly funded by the Town of Huntington, the U.S. Administration for Community Living through New York State Office for the Aging and Suffolk County Office for the Aging.
