



NY 25/25A State Bike Route

The 25A State Bike Route starts at the Cold Spring Harbor LIRR Station, at the intersection of NY Route 108 and Woodbury Road. It can be used both to commute and to tour Huntington's scenic neighborhoods. It runs along many Town of Huntington parks and can be used to travel between them. Although this is designated as "NY 25A State Bike Route," the route through the Town of Huntington mostly stays along local roads and does not actually include Route 25A.

In Kings Park, the bike route continues on NY Route 25A. The four miles along Route 25A between Kings Park and the Smithtown Bull are along designated bike lanes in the shoulder area of NY Route 25A. The eastern end of 25A State Bike Route is at the intersection of NY Route 25 and NY Route 25A, approximately one mile west of downtown Smithtown. Here, it meets NY 25 State Bike Route which then continues on to Orient Point.



Bicycle Safety:

- Always wear a helmet.
- Obey all traffic signs and signals.
- Ride with traffic.
- Use hand signals.
- Use lights at night and wear reflective clothing.
- Do not wear earphones.
- Use the appropriate lane.
- Lock your bike once you reach your destination.
