ELIGIBILITY-All Township children, Pre-Schoolers (age 4) thru sixth grade. Pre-schoolers must be 4 years old by October 1, 2016 and have proof of age. **BIRTH CERTIFICATE REQUIRED AT FIRST CLASS FOR PRE-SCHOOLERS (AGE 4).**

DATES-Saturday mornings at the Signal Hill Elementary School from October 1 thru November 19, 2016 (8 sessions). If inclement weather necessitates closing the workshop, call 351-3101 for a taped message. Parents are not permitted to sit in on classes.

FEES-are for 8 fifty-five minute classes - **checks, credit cards or money orders only**
\$69 per course per child w/Rec. ID card; \$90 per course per child w/o Rec. ID card
