On Sunday, October 26th, the Town of Huntington will be conducting a First Responder Emergency Drill in collaboration with the Dix Hills Fire Department, the Suffolk County Police Department, and surrounding fire departments including Deer Park, East Northport, Melville, and Greenlawn.

The Emergency Drill will take place at Dix Hills Park (575 Vanderbilt Parkway) between the hours of 7:30 AM and 1:00 PM.

Please be advised that this is only a training drill. The purpose of this exercise is to provide a realistic training opportunity for our local first responders to prepare for potential emergency situations. During the drill, residents may see emergency vehicles with lights and sirens in the area.

This drill is not open to the public. As this is a Fire Department training event, we ask that the public please refrain from entering the site, if possible.

We want to assure the community that normal emergency services will remain fully operational throughout the drill. If you experience an actual emergency during this time, please contact local law enforcement or emergency personnel, as you normally would.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we work together to ensure the continued safety and preparedness of our communities.
