- 4) Indicate the manner in which the material will be removed and/or deposited from the seabed (Equipment and vehicles required to perform each task shall be listed) _____

5) Indicate the estimated quantities of material to be removed or deposited. _____

6) How/where will the spoil (dredged material) be dewatered? _____

7) Where will the dredged material (spoil) be stored before transportation to disposal site? _____

8) Provide the name and location of the intended disposal site? _____

9) If piles are disturbed how are the piles going to be installed/re-installed? (Jetted, pounded, drilled, etc.) _____

10) Where are the float(s) and ramp(s) to be stored during activities? (They can not be stored in "wetland" areas) _____

Submitted plan view(s) should indicate the following;

1) Commercial

- A. Such application shall be accompanied by 3 original and 10 conformed copies of a site map or survey of the area(s) of removal and/or deposition

- B. Such application shall be accompanied by 3 original and 10 conformed copies of a topographical map with contours at two-foot intervals showing the area from which removal and/or deposition is proposed, both before and after the completion of the project
- C. Such application shall be accompanied by 3 original and 10 conformed copies of water depth sounding detailing the relationship to mean low and high water to which such removal or depositing is proposed throughout the area and the proposed angle of repose of all slopes
- D. Such application shall be accompanied by a completed Environmental Assessment Form Part I as defined in 6 NYCRR Part 617.2(m)

3) All Permit Applications

A) All *Marine Conservation Permitted* actions require complete copy of your New York State Department of Environmental Conservation permit and a copy of the approved stamped plans or a letter of non-jurisdiction.

B) All dredging plans must be signed and sealed by a Licensed New York State Professional Engineer. All land surveys must be signed and sealed by a New York State License Land Surveyor.

C) List all municipalities that maintain concurrent jurisdiction over the project site.

D) Photographs of the project site: (Polaroid photos will not be accepted)
 Submit photos on a separate page. Photographs should be taken at low tide for all projects in tidal areas. Indicate the location and direction of each photograph as well as the date and time at which the photograph was taken on a separate copy of your plan view. Provide a sufficient number of photographs to provide a clear understanding of the conditions on and proximate to your project site.

Answer the following if your project includes the construction or rehabilitation of recreational/commercial mooring facilities, residential/commercial bulkheads/seawalls or fixed platform access structures.
