CONSTRUCTION



- <u>1 Original</u> and 10 copies of the M.C.L. Construction Application.
- <u>1 Original</u> and 10 copies of an *Affidavit Of Property Owner*. (Only required if someone other than the property owner is making the application or if the application is being mailed)
- 1 copy of the Recorded Deed of Ownership.
- 1 Original and 10 copies of an Affidavit Of Prior Construction.
- <u>3 Original</u> and 8 additional copies of plans and specifications prepared by a New York State Licensed Professional Engineer.
- <u>3 Original</u> and 8 additional copies of a land survey prepared by a New York State licensed Land Surveyor. (Survey may not be dated more than 5 years prior to application submission and must bear the Mean High & Low water lines)
- <u>1 Original</u> and 10 copies of the *M.C.L. Questionnaire*. (This include photographs of the entire shoreline area with an <u>emphasis</u> on the area(s) of construction)
- 1 Original and 10 copies of S.E.Q.R.A., EAF Part I
- <u>11 copies</u> of any other permits or authorizations issued for this project. This includes Army Corp of Engineers, New York State DEC & DOS and Incorporated Villages (if applicable).
- \$ 200.00 application fee. (Check or money order)

Once a date has been set for the public hearing the applicant MUST send owners of all lands within a radius of 500 feet of subjects property lines the *Notice of Public Hearing* not less than 10 days before the hearing. Further more *Proof of Mailing* from the U.S. Post Office and the *Affidavit of Mailing* MUST be submitted to the Town Clerk's Office at least 4 days prior to the date of the hearing.
