- Computer Paper: (including blue or green lined, pin-feed printer paper)
- Copy paper
- Letterhead
- White notebook paper
- Colored Copy paper
- Adding machine tape
- Glossy paper
- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Pamphlets and brochures
- Business cards
- Envelopes
- Sticky notes
- Index cards

Top 10 most "Unwanted"

Please keep the following items out of your recycling bin. These items can contaminate the entire load and may render the material un-recyclable.

1. Food waste and Food containers, (bottles, cans, plastic cups, polystyrene, aluminum, food wrappers, etc.)
2. Restroom waste (paper towels, tissues)
3. Hanging folders with metal bars
4. Film or Photographs
5. Phone books
6. Foil Coated Paper or Carbon Paper
7. All Plastic Items
8. Colored construction paper
9. Spiral Notebooks
10. 3 ring Binders
